Dear Parent/Carer

I have been asked to make all parents aware that the Police and Children's Social Care are currently undertaking a joint child protection investigation in the Falmouth and Penryn area. This involves inappropriate behaviour on the internet by an adult. Please be aware that none of this activity has happened in school.

A number of young people have been identified and it is possible that a member of the investigation team may contact you directly in respect of your child.

A dedicated telephone line has been set up. If you have any concerns or if you think your son/daughter may have information helpful to the Police, please call **0800 731 3247** between **9.00 am and 5.00 pm**. The line will be available from **Wednesday 10th February**. Any information you or your child give will be treated sensitively.

We are very anxious to help the investigation in any way we can. There will be a representative from the Police and from Social Care available to answer any questions you may have on **Tuesday 23d February** at **Falmouth School** at **5.00 pm** and at **Penryn College** at **7.00 pm**.

We are, of course, also available in school if your child needs to talk about these matters.
